The design for a grade-separated path for pedestrians and bicyclists will enhance the recreational facility of the Charles River Basin and the Dr. Paul Dudley White Bike path. The new path and underpass tunnel will provide a means of crossing for both pedestrians and bicyclists under the Anderson Memorial Bridge while keeping close proximity to the water level but avoiding congested vehicular at-grade intersection. The architectural design of the tunnel and walkway complements the historic Anderson Bridge detailing. The tunnel and path will be illuminated at night to enhance visibility, safety and the aesthetics of the overall crossing.
