It will have a distinct color and design features that include inclined arches and fencing for open views of the river and Roosevelt Island. All details have been designed with a context sensitive architectural design theme and consistent high quality detailing. The approach spans are ADA accessible and follow a curvilinear alignment for visual appeal and interest. The new bridge will become a new gateway structure along the East River and a source of pride for the community.
