The proposed NW Quad Multi-modal bridge will cross over railroad lines owned by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) in the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts. Visually consistent ADA compliant ramps will connect to the main span. The bridge will connect two of the fastest growing neighborhoods in the City of Cambridge and encourage residents to use non-motorized modes of transportation. The bridge will be visible from long distances and will help identify the crossing in the adjacent residential areas. A new connection to the Alewife MBTA station and adjacent regional trails, via the new bridge, will help reduce congestion and create a new iconic structure in the city which will have a distinct red color, striking aesthetic lighting and refined architectural detailing.
